Voluntary Action Islington, 200a Pentonville Road, King's Cross, London, N1 9JP is a ten minute walk from King's Cross Station. Coming out of the main station, the road directly ahead of you to the right is the Euston Road (the A501). Turn left, and after the main intersection/ junction it becomes Pentonville Road. There is a McDonalds on the corner, Starbucks, Pret and Sainsbury's in succession. Across the road you'll see the Pentonville Road tube entrance/exit. Cross Killick Street, and immediately after the Tian Tian market store, you'll find a double entrance.VAI is the door on the right. Press the buzzer and the receptionist will invite you up to the 2nd floor.

King's Cross is on the edge of the Congestion charge zone. Depending on which way you approach the office, you may me liable for the daily charge.



There is car parking close to the venue, but it's relatively expensive and hard to find.

The venue is run by Islington Council and doesn't open to the public until 9am. If you're early, there are lots of coffee shops near the station and on Pentonville Road.

We welcome and receive hundreds of students, both national and international every year. This short guide is for those students who are not familiar with this locale, and to highlight the proximity of useful and interesting amenities.
